Strategic Planning Update - enVisions 20/20

On January 21 the congregation voted 94% in favour of "exploring a partnership as the preferred option in the development of a strategic plan" for our future. (This was preferred over renovating the Stilesville property or seeking a location on our own again in North Moncton). Two working groups were established: one to address the future of the Stilesville property, and the second to research and explore possibilities for partnering with other organizations. The Congregational Leadership Team (CLT) decided to contract an outside facilitator to help direct this project. The CLT applied for a grant from the United Church of Canada Edge network to help us with this project, and we have received \$2800 in funding.

Meet our facilitator Eric Tusz-King: Eric is a semi-retired Diaconal Minister. His ministry has been in local congregations (St. John United, Moncton), General Council, Maritime Conference and more recently in the community working with climate change, energy efficiency, and co-operative business development. In his semi-retired state he is making himself available to assist congregations who have specific challenges related to their ministry with their communities. Eric chaired the committee at Sackville United Church in Sackville, NB, in deciding to leave their historic building and venture into Mount Allison University chapel and later to repurpose the town hall as their church building. Now, Eric is treasurer for the congregation to guide it towards longer term sustainability. Eric is working with us on this project from May 15 to October 31st.

Update from June 24th Congregational Meeting held June 24th on the future of the Stilesville Campus: A report from the June 13 Neighbourhood Consultation was received. The following motion was passed: Visions United Church instructs the Trustees to seek the permission of Chignecto Presbytery to list for sale the Stilesville property and building, at a time to be determined by the Executive of the Congregational Leadership Team, if the property is not considered as of value for a potential partnership.
