Visions purchases a subscription to the Prayer Bench resources, and can register individuals for the personal email retreats. With this new approach you sign-up once for the whole year and you will receive one Email Retreat every month (except July and August) exploring new ideas and topics. The March and November retreat will offer an expanded edition: a small pilgrim manual with prayers and practices that will invite attention on a weekly basis during Lent and Advent: 10 Monthly Email Retreats, Holy Week Reflections; Stroll for Your Soul (spring); Summer Sabbath.
