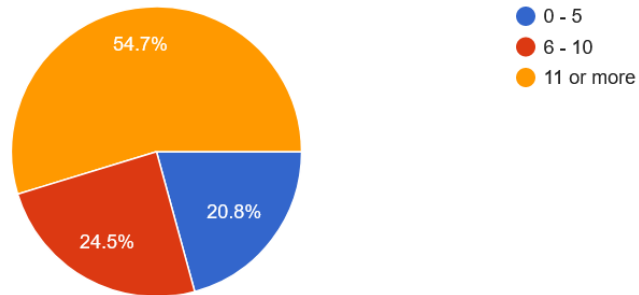


Q1

As of August 16, Visions United held 15 ONLINE VIRTUAL Spirit Gatherings. How many did you attend?

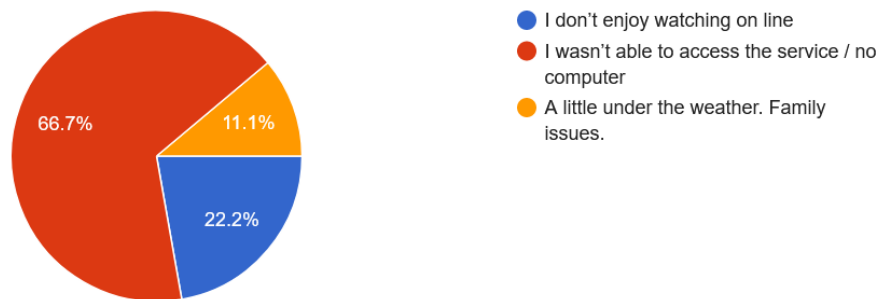

If we continue to hold ONLINE VIRTUAL Spirit Gatherings, will you continue to view the service?

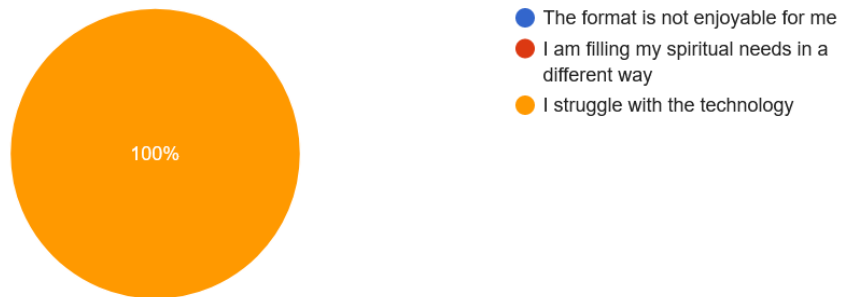

You indicated you would not continue to watch services on-line. Can you tell us why?

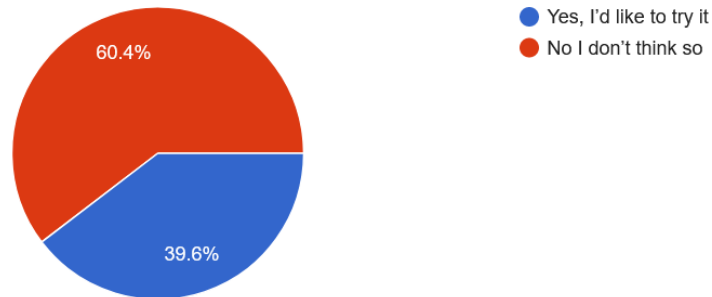

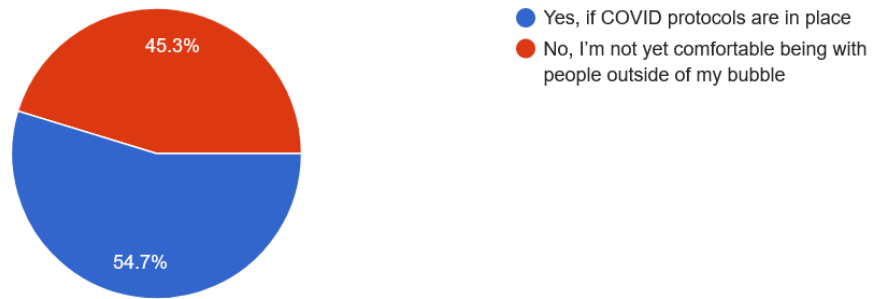


- One of the advantages of a pre recorded service is not having to view it at a specific time. One of the disadvantages is becoming "lazy" and forgetting to view it.

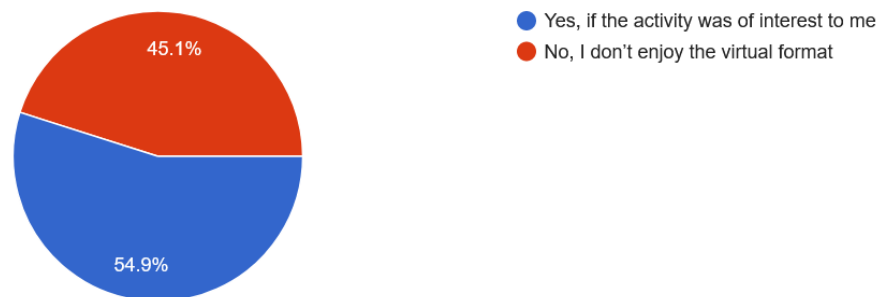

Would you be interested in attending other ONLINE VIRTUAL group activities using video conferencing through your computer, tablet or phone, with instruction provided as needed?

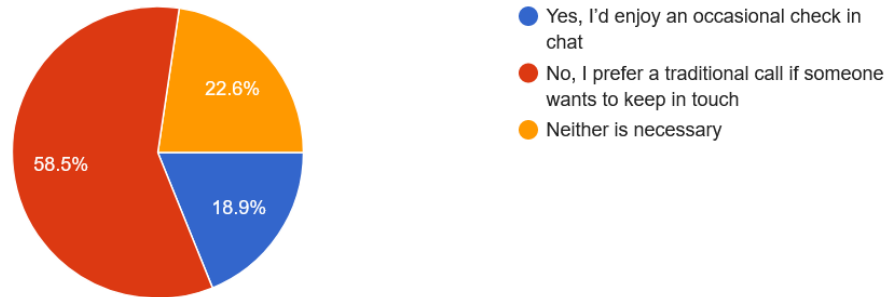

Are you interested in participating in a periodic ONLINE VIRTUAL check-in chat with Shawn or others, to keep in touch?

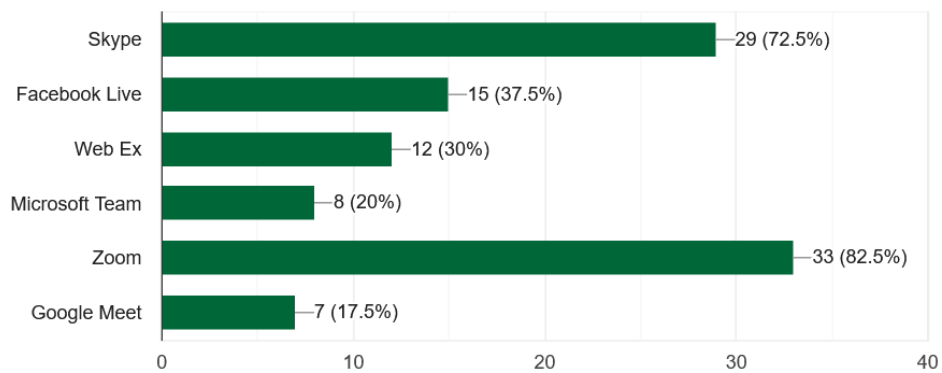

Which of these technologies have you used before?

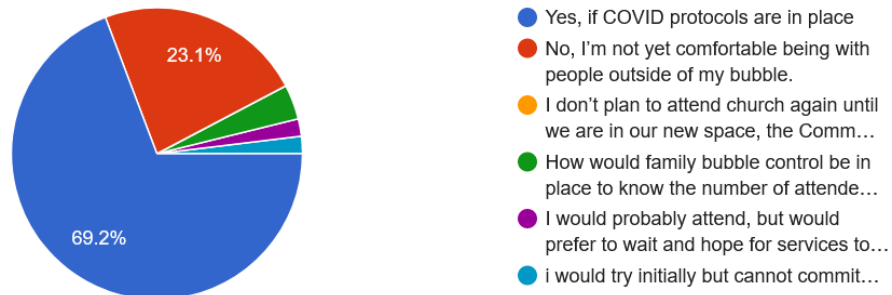

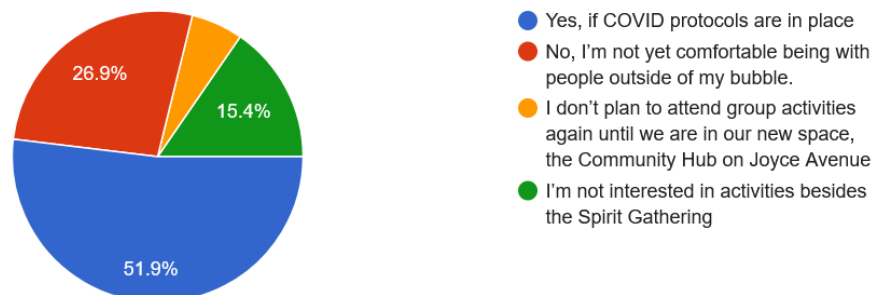


- I don't plan to attend church again until we are in our new space, the Community Hub on Joyce Avenue
