

Visions United Covid-19 Protocol for In-Person Gatherings at Père Patrice LeBlanc Centre, 91 Murphy Avenue

What to expect, to maximally protect you, your family, and others:

Quota: Maximum 50 indoor attendees at one time, including volunteers

Registration: To avoid overflow numbers and make entry more efficient, weekly pre-registration will be done, including by staff/volunteers. This will include standard COVID-19 screening questions (*see below). Registration will open Wednesday morning at 9:00am and close Saturday at 12:00pm for the following Sunday. Anyone not pre-registered will be admitted as available space permits on a first-come, first-served basis.

How to register?

- Online at www.visionsunited.ca
- Look for the registration button, click on it and follow the instructions. You will need to enter your name and the number of household bubble members who will be attending. Only 1 person per household bubble needs to complete this form.
- Next read the Covid-19 Protocols available on the same page.
- If you do not have internet access please register by phone (506-384-0843) beginning on the Wednesday morning prior to that week's Spirit Gathering. Phone registration ends Friday at noon.
- If you need to cancel after you register please email register@visionsunited.ca or you can call the office by 1pm on Friday.

Parking lot: In the (large) parking lot when outside of vehicles, 6-foot (2-metre) distancing between individuals or family bubbles, or mask use by all except children under 2 years of age.

Masks/physical distancing: You are reminded to maintain the above physical distancing between individuals/family bubbles indoors and all those inside will be required to remain masked continuously, except children under 2 years of age, and except the Minister who is permitted to unmask only while behind the podium.

Entrance/exit: All entrance and exit will be through the left-hand door (with stairs), except for those using the elevator-lift through the right-hand door – cloakroom is inside the left door.

Sanitation: Touch surfaces will have been disinfected before your arrival by 91 Murphy Ave. staff as well as by Visions volunteers.

Greeting/Registration Desk: At an inside table, attendance name and phone number will be verified/recorded to allow contact tracing if needed. COVID-19 screening answers will be reconfirmed by these entrance desk attendees.

Giving Table: This will be located near the entrance to receive offerings and for donations to the ReConnect Jar.

Seating: After hand-sanitizing, individuals/family bubbles will each be seated by an available usher to a physically-distanced chair.

Vocalizing: No singing will be done indoors, although quiet humming is permitted, and musical instruments requiring “lung power” will not be used. Attendees will speak at normal volume (masked) during responsive readings. Some participating attendees will be “pre-booked” to use a provided no-touch microphone and will be seated appropriately to maintain proper distancing, including Wow Moments which would need to be submitted to the Minister ahead of time.

Refreshments: No nourishment to be used except “self-brought/self-consumed”.

Exit: Orderly exiting will be supervised by ushers to maintain proper distancing, using the same door as entrance, with hand-sanitizer use by all.

***Atlantic Bubble COVID-19 screening questions
to be asked weekly as a prerequisite to attend:**

- ✓ Have you been outside the Atlantic Provinces in the last 14 days?
- ✓ Do you have any of the following symptoms: fever or chills, new or worsening cough, sore throat, runny nose, headache, diarrhea, new onset fatigue, new onset muscle aches, loss of taste or smell?
- ✓ Have you been in contact with anyone, including your family or direct social network that has been sick with any of these symptoms?
- ✓ Have you been in contact with a known case of COVID-19, or have been in a setting (i.e. work camp) where cases have been identified?
- ✓ Has anyone in your family or direct social network been sick with any of these symptoms?
